**ORDER**

On December 9, 2015, the Magistrate Judge issued a Report and Recommendation in this case recommending that the Court dismiss the claims of opt-in Plaintiffs Mark Cameron and Herman Liggett with prejudice for failure to prosecute pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b) (ECF No. 95). The Report and Recommendation advised the parties that failure to object within fourteen days would result in a waiver of review.
