ORDER

On September 28, 2017, the United States Magistrate Judge recommended that the Court grant Defendant's Unopposed Motion for an Indicative Ruling on a Motion for Relief from Judgment [ECF No. 28] and issue an order indicating that it is inclined to grant relief from its March 27, 2017 judgment entry should the court of appeals remand for that purpose.
