**OPINION AND ORDER**

On November 1, 2017, the Magistrate Judge issued a *Report and Recommendation* pursuant to Rule 4 of the Rules governing Section 2254 Cases in the United States District Courts recommending that this action be dismissed. Petitioner has failed his right to appeal by failing to file objections. *See Thomas v. Arn*, 474 U.S. 140 (1985); *United States v. Walters*, 638 F.2d 947 (6th Cir. 1981). Therefore, the Court **DECLINES** to issue a certificate of appealability.
