**OPINION AND ORDER**

On April 21, 2022, the Magistrate Judge in this case issued a Report and Recommendation proposing that the decision of the Commissioner, denying disability benefits to the Plaintiff, be AFFIRMED. (ECF No. 23.) The Plaintiff filed a timely objection. (ECF No. 24.)
