ORDER

Plaintiff sued multiple defendants under 42 U.S.C. § 1983, Compl., ECF No. 1, but she failed to sign the Complaint, attach a civil cover sheet, and either pay the filing fee or move for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*, Notice, ECF No. 2. Plaintiff then failed to comply with the deficiency order pointing out those defects. Order, ECF No. 3. The Magistrate Judge thus issued a Report and Recommendation (“R&R”) recommending the Court dismiss this case for failure to prosecute. R&R, ECF No. 4. The R&R notified Plaintiff of her right to object to the recommendation and of the consequences of failing to do so. R&R 2, ECF No. 4. Plaintiff failed to timely object.¹

As Plaintiff failed to timely object to the R&R, the Court **ADOPTS** the same without further review and **DISMISSES WITHOUT PREJUDICE** the Complaint in

this case pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b) for failure to prosecute.
