DECISION AND ENTRY ADOPTING REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS FILED ON JANUARY 17, 2008(DOC. #12); REMANDING CASE TO THE COMMISSIONER AND THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE UNDER SENTENCE FOUR OF 42 U.S.C. §405(G) TERMINATION ENTRY
