

**DECISION AND ENTRY ADOPTING REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS FILED ON
FEBRUARY 5, 2010 (Doc. #10); DISMISSING PLAINTIFF MARK MARTIN'S COMPLAINT;
DISMISSING DEFENDANT DANIEL DOBSON'S COUNTERCLAIMS AND THIRD PARTY
CLAIMS; AND TERMINATING THE CASE ON THE DOCKET OF THIS COURT**

The Court has conducted a de novo review of the Report and Recommendations of United States Magistrate Judge Sharon L.
