DECISION AND ENTRY

The Court has conducted a de novo review of the Report and Recommendations of United States Magistrate Judge Sharon L. R. Civ. P. 72(b) has expired, hereby ADOPTS said Report and Recommendations.

- Plaintiff's Motion for an Award of Attorney Fees Pursuant to the Equal Justice 2. Act (Doc. #16) is GRANTED, and the Commissioner is ordered to pay Plaintiff's attorney fees and costs in the total amount of \$4,496.25;
- 3. The Commissioner is directed to verify, within twenty-one days from the date of this Decision and Entry, whether or not Plaintiff owes a pre-existing debt to

the United States that is subject to offset. The Commissioner is further ordered to pay the EAJA award directly to Plaintiff's counsel, if no such pre-existing debt exists; and

4. The case remains terminated on the docket of this Court.
