DECISION AND ENTRY

This case is before the Court upon Plaintiff's Motion for Allowance of Attorney Fees pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 406(b). (Doc. #17). The Commissioner has neither responded to nor opposed the Motion, and the time for filing such opposition has expired. *See* S.D. Ohio Civ. R. 7.2(a)(2).

The Motion seeks an award of attorney fees under 42 U.S.C. § 406(b)(1) in the total amount of \$27,178.15.
