DEFICIENCY ORDER

Plaintiff, a prisoner at the Southern Ohio Correctional Facility, and proceeding *pro se*, has filed a complaint. Plaintiff is **ADVISED** that, if the issue of the filing fee is not addressed by the September 16, 2013 deadline, the Court will recommend that this case be closed, and Plaintiff's complaint dismissed, due to his lack of prosecution and failure to comply with this Order.

The Clerk shall promptly mail a copy of this Order, an Application and Affidavit by an Incarcerated Person to Proceed Without Prepayment of Fees and Costs, and a civil cover sheet to Plaintiff at the address on the docket.
