ORDER

The Court held a lengthy telephone conference on April 15, 2014 at the request of Defendant's counsel to address issues related to the scheduling of depositions. *Pro se* Plaintiff and counsel for Defendant were afforded the opportunity to be fully heard on the matter.

As previously ordered, the deposition of Plaintiff, Joseph Rieger, will occur on April 29, 2014 beginning at 9:30 a.m. in Courtroom 5 of the Federal Courthouse in Dayton. Doc. 31. The parties advised the Court that they have been unable to agree to the scheduling of depositions for six of Defendant's witnesses. Defendant objected to two additional witnesses, Teresa Burke and Andrea Hicks, being deposed at all; Plaintiff seeks to have these depositions occur immediately after his deposition.

For good cause shown, it is **ORDERED** that Plaintiff may depose Teresa Burke and Andrea Hicks. The eight depositions will occur on the following dates and locations:

The parties are directed to review Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 28 and 30, as well as Local Rule 30.1, which govern the requirements and procedures of depositions. Costs shall be borne by the deposing party. Both parties are **ADVISED** that failure to comply with these requirements and procedures may result in a waiver of the deposition.
