PRELIMINARY PRETRIAL CONFERENCE ORDER; FURTHER PROCEDURES SET

The captioned cause came on to be heard upon a preliminary pretrial conference held on July 14, 2014.

The pivotal issue appears to be whether the administrative record, to be furnished by Defendant to Plaintiff no later than July 25, 2014, will need to be supplemented. If Plaintiff feels the need for such, an informal request to Defendants will be made by August 8, 2014. If informal supplementation of the record does not occur, Plaintiffs shall file a motion seeking discovery with the Court by September 1, 2014. The Defendant will then respond within fourteen days thereafter, following which this Court will make an order on the issue of supplementation. If no supplementation is needed, simultaneous motions for judgment on the administrative record/supplementation of same will be filed not later than January 16, 2015, with simultaneous replies to be filed on February 16, 2015.

Should the issue of supplementation need to be “litigated,” the Court will convene a telephone conference call shortly after the filing of its decision. In that event, the date for filing motions for judgment on the administrative record, whether supplemented or not, will be adjusted.
