RECOMMENDATIONS OF UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE
MERZ (DOC. 7), OVERRULING PETITIONER'S OBJECTIONS TO THE
MAGISTRATE'S FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS, (DOC. 8), AND
DENYING MOTION FOR LEAVE TO APPEAL *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*,

Pending before the Court are Petitioner Demian Joseph Pina's Objections to the Magistrate's Report and Recommendations. (Doc. 8).
