## **DECISION AND ENTRY**

The Court has conducted a *de novo* review of the Report and Recommendations of Chief United States Magistrate Judge Sharon L. Ovington (Doc. #16), to whom this case was originally referred pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b). Noting that no objections have been filed and that the time for filing such objections, if any, under Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b), has expired, this Court hereby **ADOPTS** said Report and Recommendations.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that:

- 1. The Report and Recommendations filed on July 6, 2016 (Doc. #16) is ADOPTED in full;
- 2. The Commissioner's non-disability finding be vacated;
- 3. No finding be made as to whether Plaintiff Gerald K. Schreier was under a "disability" within the meaning of the Social Security Act;
- 4. This matter be **REMANDED** to the Social Security Administration under sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) for further consideration consistent with the Report and Recommendations, and this Decision and Entry; and
- 5. The case is terminated on the docket of this Court.
