DECISION AND ENTRY

The Court has conducted a de novo review of the Report and Recommendations of

Chief United States Magistrate Judge Sharon L. Ovington (Doc. #12), to whom this case

was originally referred pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b). Noting that no objections have

been filed and that the time for filing such objections, if any, under Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b),

has expired, this Court hereby ADOPTS said Report and Recommendations.

- 2. The Commissioner's non-disability finding be vacated;
- 3. No finding be made as to whether Plaintiff Bonnie M. Wilson was under a "disability" within the meaning of the Social Security Act;
- 4. This matter be **REMANDED** to the Social Security Administration under sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) for further consideration consistent with this Decision and Entry; and
- 5. The case is terminated on the docket of this Court.
