The Court has reviewed the Report and Recommendations of United States Magistrate Judge Sharon L. Ovington (Doc. #28), to whom this case was originally referred pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b), and noting that no objections have been filed thereto and that the time for filing such objections under Fed. 3. Defendants' Motion to Dismiss (Doc. #20) is **DENIED** as moot without prejudice to renewal and without prejudice to Defendants' option of filing a Motion for Summary Judgment accompanied by Plaintiff's medical records or other discovery materials.
