ORDER ADOPTING IN PART REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS ON MOTIONS TO DISMISS

This case is before the Court on the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendations (ECF No. 41) recommending that the Motion to Dismiss of Defendant Steve Layman (ECF No. 9) be granted in its entirety and the Motion to Dismiss of Defendants Dave Duchak, Elizabeth Gutmann, and Rob Davie (ECF No. 7) be granted in part. The Report was served on Petitioner Marcum on February 23, 2018, and he was notified that any objections were required to be served not later than seventeen days later (ECF No. 41, PageID 639). Thus his time to file and serve objections expired March 12, 2018, but he has filed no objections.

Accordingly, the Report and Recommendations are ADOPTED insofar as they recommend dismissing with prejudice all claims against Defendants Layman, Gutmann, and Davie and all

claims against Defendant Duchak except for Marcum's Equal Protection claim regarding failure to provide a free telephone call to contact a bondsman or attorney¹.
