## **DECISION AND ENTRY**

This Social Security case is presently before the Court on the parties' Joint Motion for Remand. (Doc. 10.) The parties agree that this Court should enter a judgment in favor of Plaintiff, reversing the Commissioner's decision under Sentence Four of Section 205 of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) and remanding the cause to the Commissioner for further administrative proceedings consistent with this motion. The parties further agree that upon remand, the Appeals Council will vacate all findings in the Administrative Law Judge's decision. The Commissioner will develop the administrative record as necessary to determine whether Plaintiff is disabled within the meaning of the Social Security Act, hold a new hearing, and issue a new decision.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The parties' Joint Motion for Remand (Doc. No. 10) is ACCEPTED;

- 2. The Clerk of Court is directed to enter Judgment in Plaintiff's favor under Fed. R. Civ. P. 58;
- 3. This matter is **REMANDED** to the Social Security Administration, pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g), for further consideration consistent with this Decision and Entry and the parties' Motion; and
- 4. The case is terminated on the docket of this Court.
