OPINION AND ORDER DENYING CERTIFICATE OF APPEALABILITY

Petitioner has filed a notice of intent to appeal the court's order entered September 24, 2013, affirming and adopting the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation and denying petitioner's petition for a writ of habeas corpus.
