Before the Court is the plaintiffs' Proof of Payment of Post-Judgment Interest. An examination of the documentation offered as support of their proof of payment reveals that rather than comply with the Court's September 6, 2007 order specifying July 16, 2007 as the date from which post-judgment interest calculations were to be made, the plaintiffs instead paid to the defendant interest calculated from August 16, 2007. The plaintiffs failed to acknowledge, much less address, the discrepancy between their calculations and the Court's order. While the Court regrets the additional resources that will be expended over trivial sums, it has little option but to find that the plaintiffs' have failed to establish that they have satisfied the judgment against them. The plaintiffs' Motion to Deem Judgment Satisfied is therefore, DENIED.
