## **ORDER**

On April 29, 2009, United States Magistrate Judge Doyle Argo issued a Report and Recommendation in this action brought pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983, alleging the violation of certain constitutional rights during plaintiff's incarceration at the Oklahoma County Detention Center ("OCDC"). The Magistrate Judge recommends the Court dismiss without prejudice plaintiff's claims against defendant Michael Ofsack and "John Doe-Officers, defendants 3, 4, 5, and 6" pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(m) based upon plaintiff's failure to timely serve them.
