## <u>ORDER</u>

This action seeking habeas corpus relief pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254, brought by an immigration detainee proceeding <u>prose</u>, was referred to United States Magistrate Judge Bana Roberts, consistent with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B). Judge Roberts entered a Report and Recommendation on November 24, 2010, recommending dismissal for lack of jurisdiction. The court file reflects that no party has objected to the Report and Recommendation within the time limits prescribed.<sup>\*</sup> Therefore, the Court adopts the Report and Recommendation. Because no amendment can cure the defect, the dismissal acts as an adjudication on the merits and a judgment will enter.

Accordingly, the Report and Recommendation of the Magistrate Judge is adopted, in part, and this case is denied for lack of jurisdiction. A judgment will enter accordingly.
