ORDER

Plaintiff Fred Smith, an Oklahoma prisoner appearing pro se, has filed an Amended Complaint (Doc. Nos. 36 to 37). That amended pleading replaces his original Complaint (Doc. Nos. 1 to 1-7) challenging the Oklahoma Department of Corrections’ (“ODOC”) written policy governing inmates’ access to religious meals and items. See Order of June 30, 2017 (Doc. No. 34) at 2-3. The Amended Complaint, which does not name ODOC as a Defendant, is subject to preliminary screening. See 28 U.S.C. § 1915A; 42 U.S.C § 1997e; *Plunk v. Givens*, 234 F.3d 1128, 1129-30 (10th Cir. 2000); Order of June 30, 2017, at 2-3; Order of Nov. 7, 2016 (Doc. No. 17) at 2 n.1. Accordingly, the Clerk of the Court shall not issue service of process for any Defendant named in the Amended Complaint until directed to do so. See LCvR 9.2(c); Order of June 30, 2017, at 2-3.
