ORDER

On November 28, 2017, United Magistrate Judge Charles B. Goodwin issued a Report and Recommendation in which Petitioner filed a 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action in September 2017. The plaintiff failed to pay the initial partial filing fee on at least two occasions after being warned by the Magistrate Judge that his case would be dismissed for failure to follow court orders.
