HERNÁNDEZ, District Judge:

Magistrate Judge Sullivan issued a Findings and Recommendation [56] on June 30, 2014,

in which she recommends that this Court grant the Department of Interior's Motion to Dismiss

[53], grant Attorney General Holder's Motion to Dismiss [54], and dismiss Mr. Pringle's

Amended Complaint [4].

The matter is now before me pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 72(b).

Because no objections to the Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendation were timely filed, I am relieved of my obligation to review the record *de novo*. <u>United States v.</u> <u>Reyna-Tapia</u>, 328 F.3d 1114, 1121 (9th Cir. 2003) (en banc); <u>see also United States v. Bernhardt</u>, 840 F.2d 1441, 1444 (9th Cir. 1988) (*de novo* review required only for portions of Magistrate Judge's report to which objections have been made). Having reviewed the legal principles *de novo*, I find no error.

CONCLUSION

The Court ADOPTS Magistrate Judge Sullivan's Findings & Recommendation [56]. Accordingly, the Department of Interior's Motion to Dismiss [53] is granted, Attorney General Holder's Motion to Dismiss [54] is granted, and Mr. Pringle's Amended Complaint [4] is dismissed, without prejudice.
