1 - OPINION AND ORDER

#### BROWN, Judge.

Magistrate Judge Dennis James Hubel issued Findings and Recommendation (#55) on March 3, 2011, in which he recommends this Court deny Defendants' Motion (#24) for Summary Judgment. The matter is now before this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 72(b).

Because no objections to the Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendation were timely filed, this Court is relieved of its obligation to review the record *de novo*. *United States v*. Reyna-Tapia, 328 F.3d 1114, 1121 (9<sup>th</sup> Cir. 2003)(*en banc*). *See also* United *States v*. *Bernhardt*, 840 F.2d 1441, 1444 (9<sup>th</sup> Cir. 1988). Having reviewed the legal principles *de novo*, the Court does not find any error.

#### CONCLUSION

The Court **ADOPTS** Magistrate Judge Hubel's Findings and Recommendation (#55). Accordingly, the Court **DENIES** Defendants' Motion (#24) for Summary Judgment.
