Magistrate Judge Janice M. Stewart issued Findings and Recommendation (#100) on July 19, 2011, in which she recommends this Court grant State Defendants' Motion (#47) to Dismiss, grant the Motion (#54) to Dismiss of Portland General Electric (PGE), 1 - ORDER
