## BROWN, Judge.

Magistrate Judge Janice M. Stewart issued Findings and Recommendation (#76) on March 18, 2013, in which she recommends this Court grant the Motion (#39) of Columbia State Bank to Dismiss Columbia River Bank for Lack of Prosecution. The matter 1 - ORDER
