Magistrate Judge Patricia Sullivan issued Findings and Recommendation (#27) on March 18, 2014, in which she recommends this Court deny Petitioner Liviu Stefan's Petition (#1) for Writ of Habeas Corpus, dismiss this matter with prejudice, and deny a certificate of appealability. 
Because no objections to the Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendation were timely filed, this Court is relieved of its obligation to review the record *de novo*. *United States v. Reyna-Tapia*, 328 F.3d 1114, 1121 (9<sup>th</sup> Cir. 2003) (*en banc*). See also *United States v. Bernhardt*, 840 F.2d 1441, 1444 (9<sup>th</sup> Cir. 1988). Having reviewed the legal principles *de novo*, the Court does not find any error.

**CONCLUSION**

The Court **ADOPTS** Magistrate Judge Sullivan's Findings and Recommendation (#27). Accordingly, the Court **DENIES** the Petition (#1) for Writ of Habeas Corpus, **DISMISSES** this matter **with prejudice**, and **DENIES** a certificate of appealability.
