Beckerman issued Findings and Recommendation (#24) on January 30, 2017, in which she recommends this Court grant in part and deny in part Plaintiff's Motion (#17) for Order Awarding Plaintiff Attorneys' Fees and Costs and award Plaintiff attorneys' fees in the amount of \$16,870.00 and


Because no objections to the Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendation were timely filed, this Court is relieved of its obligation to review the record *de novo*. See *Dawson v. Marshall*, 561 F.3d 930, 932 (9<sup>th</sup> Cir. 2009). See also *United States v. Reyna-Tapia*, 328 F.3d 1114, 1121 (9<sup>th</sup> Cir. 2003) (*en banc*). Having reviewed the legal principles *de novo*, the Court does not find any error.

#### CONCLUSION

The Court **ADOPTS** Magistrate Judge Beckerman's Findings and Recommendation (#24). Accordingly, the Court **GRANTS in part** and **DENIES in part** Plaintiff's Motion (#17) for Order Awarding Plaintiff Attorneys' Fees and Costs and **AWARDS** Plaintiff attorneys' fees of **\$16,870.00** and costs of **\$1,538.97**.
