Based on the stipulation of the parties, it is hereby ORDERED that the abovecaptioned case be REVERSED and REMANDED for a de novo hearing pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g). Upon remand, the administrative law judge (ALJ) will reweigh the medical opinions, including the opinions of Joshua Boyd, Psy.D., and Sandra Lundblad, Psy.D. The ALJ will reassess Plaintiff's residual functional capacity. The ALJ will obtain vocational expert testimony at steps four and five of the sequential evaluation process.

Plaintiff is entitled to reasonable attorney fees, expenses, and costs under the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. §§ 2412 and 1920, upon proper request to the Court.
