Magistrate Judge Mark D. Clarke filed a Report and Recommendation ("R&R"), ECF No. 22, and the matter is now before this Court. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B); Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b). Although the Commissioner of Social Security filed no objections, I have reviewed the legal principles *de novo*. *See United States v. Bernhardt*, 840 F.2d 1441, 1445 (9th Cir. 1998).
