ORDER

AND NOW, this ___ day of _____, 2011, upon consideration of the Defendants’ Renewed Motion For Judgment As A Matter Of Law Or, Alternatively, For A New Trial (the “Motion”), the parties’ submissions in support thereof and in opposition thereto, the arguments and/or hearings thereon, and all prior pleadings and proceedings had herein,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendants’ Motion is GRANTED pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 50(b).
