- GRANTED, in part, and the following claims in Plaintiff's Second Amended Complaint (ECF 22) are DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE
  - a. "Counts" 1 through 3, claiming violations of
    - i. The Fourth Amendment for unlawful search and seizure, and
    - ii. The First Amendment for retaliation against protected speech; and
  - b. "Counts" 9, 10, and 12, claiming violations of state law for
    - i. False imprisonment,
    - ii. Malicious prosecution, and
    - iii. Invasion of privacy.
- 2. DENIED, in part, with respect to
  - a. "Counts" 4 and 5, claiming violations of

- i. The Fourteenth Amendment for denial of procedural due process, and
- ii. Section 1983 for conspiracy; and
- 3. "Counts" 11 and 13, claiming violations of state law for
  - a. Abuse of process, and
  - b. Conspiracy; and
- 4. Dismissal of the City of Chester as a defendant in this case
