- 2. Plaintiffs are likely to succeed on the merits of their claims for copyright infringement under 17 U.S.C. § 502(a);
 - 3. Plaintiffs lack an adequate remedy at law;
 - 4. The balance of hardships tips in Plaintiffs' favor; and
 - 5. The public interest weighs in favor of the requested relief;

Accordingly, this day of, 2012, IT IS SO ORDERED that:
1. Defendant John Doe, his agents, officers, employees, and representatives, and all
persons acting in concert or participating with him, shall be enjoined from any further
publication of Plaintiffs' copyrighted materials, which are currently being displayed at
http://www.secretlivessexbloggers.blogspot.com/, including but not limited to any further
publication of the copyrighted materials online.
2. If Defendants elect to file Plaintiffs' copyrighted materials as an exhibit in this
action, they should do so under seal.
