AND NOW, this 20th day of Nov., 2013, upon careful and independent consideration of the petition for Writ of *Habeas Corpus*, and after review of the Report and Recommendation of United States Magistrate Judge Linda K. Caracappa, IT IS ORDERED that:

- i. The Report and Recommendation is APPROVED and ADOPTED.
- ii. The petition for Writ of *Habeas Corpus* is STAYED and held in ABEYANCE until the conclusion of petitioner's state court proceedings.
- iii. Petitioner shall notify this federal court within forty-five (45) days following the conclusion of his state court proceedings.
