¹ The United States has represented to the Court that, upon dismissal of any FTCA claims, "the United States would be willing to stipulate with Ms. Pollard that, on condition that she will not appeal the dismissal, the United States will voluntarily dismiss its counterclaim against her without prejudice, so that this action can be dismissed and she can proceed on her claims against the City of Philadelphia in the Court of Common Pleas for Philadelphia County." (Doc. No. 10). Plaintiff replied that she "is agreeable with the proposed recommendation" of the United States. (Doc. No. 11). The Court will consider the stipulation and notice of voluntary dismissal when these documents have been filed.
