AND NOW, this 21st day of July, 2017, upon consideration of Plaintiff’s Motion for Certification (ECF No. 73); Defendant’s Motion to De-certify Conditionally Certified Collective Action Class (ECF No. 100); and Defendant’s Motion for Summary Judgment (ECF No. 104), and all documents and exhibits submitted in support thereof, and in opposition thereto, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. Plaintiff’s Motion for Certification of her claims under the WPCL (ECF No. 73) is **DENIED**.
2. Defendant’s Motion to De-certify the Conditionally Certified Collective Action Class under the FLSA (ECF No. 100) is **GRANTED**.
