AND NOW, this 30th day of March 2015, upon consideration of Defendants' Motion to Refer Action to Bankruptcy Court [Doc. No. 13], the Motion of Ashland Funding, LLC to Dismiss Complaint [Doc. No. 16], DVI Defendants' Motion to Dismiss Complaint [Doc. No. 17], and the Motion of Defendants U.S. Bank, N.A. and Jane Fox to Dismiss Complaint [Doc.
