The Motion to Strike the Affidavit of Service is **GRANTED**. The Motions to Seal the Complaint and to Strike Certain Paragraphs are **DENIED**.
- 4. Plaintiff's request for jurisdictional discovery is **DENIED**.
- 5. Plaintiff's request for reimbursement of service costs is **DENIED**.
