**ORDER**

AND NOW, this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of May 2017, upon consideration of Plaintiff Karen Phillips’s (“Plaintiff”) *objections to the report and recommendation of the magistrate judge*, [ECF 18], Defendant’s response thereto, [ECF 20], the *Report and Recommendation* issued on August 18, 2016, by the Honorable Timothy R. Rice, United States Magistrate Judge, [ECF 17], and the administrative record, [ECF 6], it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. Plaintiff’s objections are **SUSTAINED**, *in part*, and **OVERRULED**, *in part*;

4. The Clerk of Court is directed to mark this matter **CLOSED**.
