¹ In light of our ruling that Plaintiff's individual claim survives, there is no basis for Defendant to assert that Plaintiff cannot serve as a representative of a class potentially certified to pursue a claim under 15 U.S.C. § 1681k. We find that Defendant's challenges to the viability under Rule 23 of the proposed classes defined in the Amended Complaint are premature, as Plaintiff has not yet conducted discovery and filed a certification motion.
