AND NOW, this 9th day of June, 2016, upon consideration of defendant Hospitality Supportive Systems, LLC's ("HSS") motion to dismiss Counts I and II of plaintiff Aspen Specialty Insurance Company's ("Aspen") complaint pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(6), or in the alternative, for a more specific pleading under Fed. R. Civ.
