AND NOW, this 19th day of May, 2017, upon consideration of Plaintiff's Request for Review, Defendant's Response to Request for Review, Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment, the record in this case, the Report and Recommendation of United States Magistrate Judge Timothy R.
