AND NOW, this 6th day of July, 2017, upon consideration of Defendants' Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint, or in the Alternative for Summary Judgment (Docket No. 19), Plaintiff's "Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment" (Docket No. 22), and all responses, replies and exhibits filed by both parties, it is hereby **ORDERED** as follows:
