## ORDER

AND NOW, this 10<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2017, upon consideration of Plaintiff's

Motion for Leave to Seek Jurisdictional Discovery (Doc. No. 47), as well as the replies

and responses thereto, I HEREBY ORDER:

- 1. Plaintiff's motion is **GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART**. Limited jurisdictional discovery is **GRANTED** as to Defendant AXA Corporate Solutions Assurance, S.A, Inc., and **DENIED** as to Defendant AXA Insurance Company; and
- 2. Defendant AXA Corporate Solutions Assurance, S.A, Inc.'s, motion to dismiss (Doc. No. 34) shall be **STAYED** during the pendency of jurisdictional discovery.

## IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

- By no later than October 25, 2017, Plaintiff may serve no more than ten (10) interrogatories upon Defendant AXA Corporate Solutions Assurance, S.A., limited to the issue of personal jurisdiction;
- Plaintiff may conduct no more than three (3) depositions limited to the issue of personal jurisdiction. Depositions shall be completed no later than December 8, 2017, and may be conducted by telephone or video conference; and

5. The parties will submit supplemental filings by **December 22, 2017**, with responses due **January 5, 2017**.
