**AND NOW** this 5<sup>th</sup> day of October 2017, upon independent review of United States Magistrate Judge Marilyn Heffley's September 19, 2017 Report and Recommendation (ECF Doc. No. 21) recommending a denial of the Petitioner's untimely Petition for writ of *habeas corpus* under 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (ECF Doc. No. 1), Petitioner's Objections (ECF Doc.
