AND NOW, this 29th day of November, 2017, upon consideration of defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc. No. 10), defendant's statement of Material Facts in Support of Its Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc. No. 11), plaintiff's Cross Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc. No. 13), and defendant's Response in Support of Its Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc.
