This 28th day of March, 2018, upon consideration of Defendant Wells Fargo Bank, N.A.'s Motion to Dismiss and to Strike Class Allegations, ECF No. 16, and Plaintiffs Frank Hightower and Chamicka Pollock's Response in Opposition, ECF No. 18, it is hereby

ORDERED that:

- Defendant's Motion to Strike Plaintiffs' class allegations is GRANTED without prejudice, and the class allegations are hereby stricken from the Amended Complaint;
