**ORDER**

AND NOW, this 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 2020, upon consideration of: the Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (ECF No. 1); Petitioner's Addendum (ECF No. 11); the Commonwealth's Response thereto (ECF No. 7); the Report and Recommendation of United States Magistrate Judge Richard Lloret (ECF No. 12); Petitioner's Objections thereto (ECF Nos. 15, 17); and, the Commonwealth's Response to Petitioner's Objections (ECF No. 21), it is hereby ORDERED as follows:
